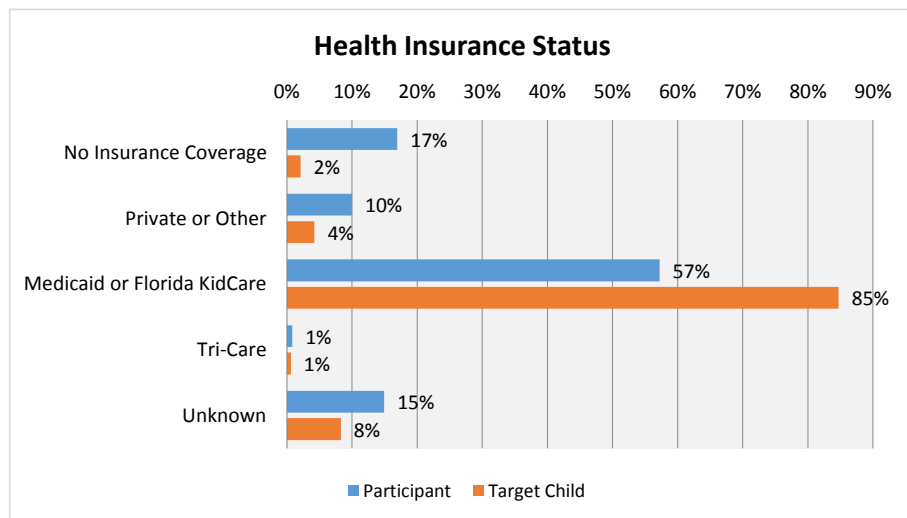

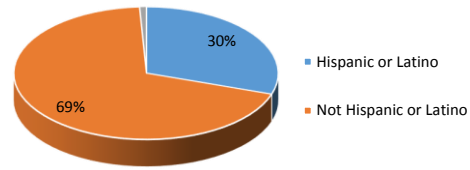
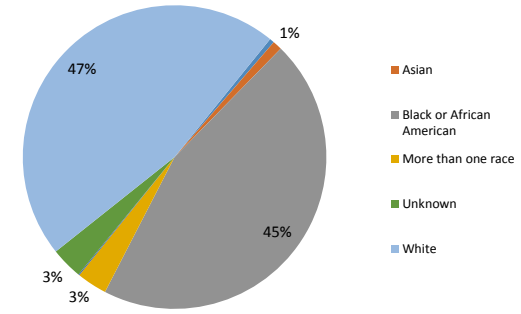

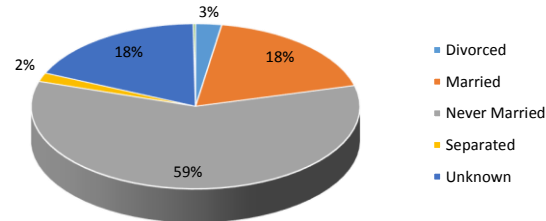

### Participant Marital Status

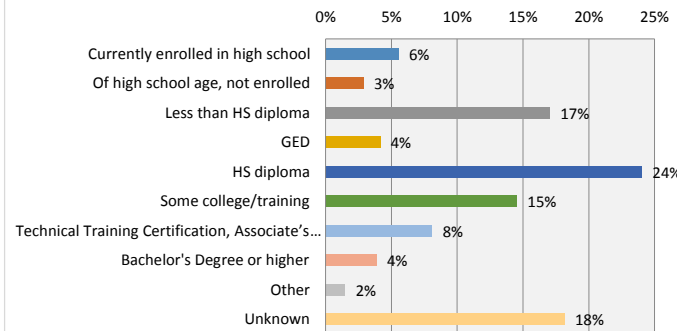

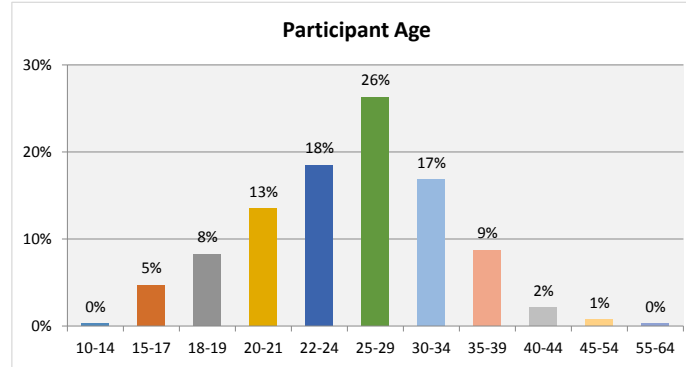

### Participant Educational Attainment



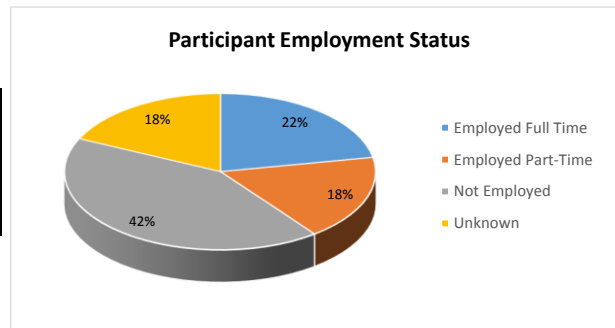

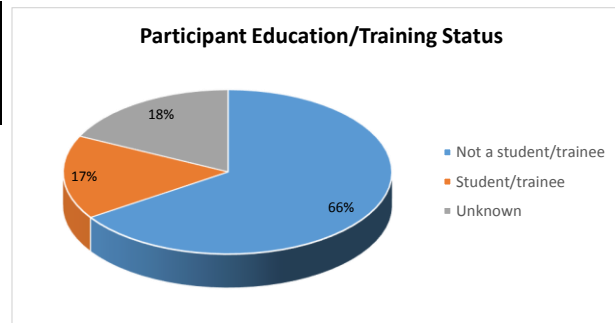

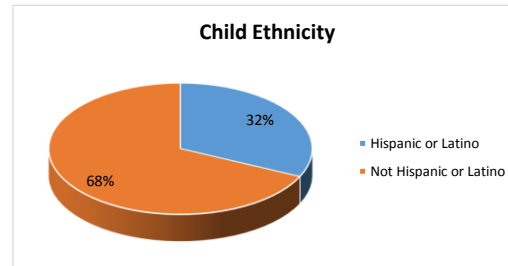

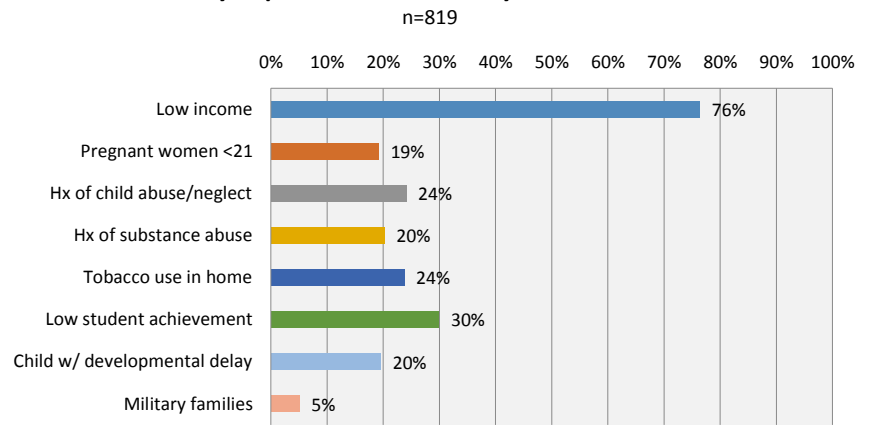
