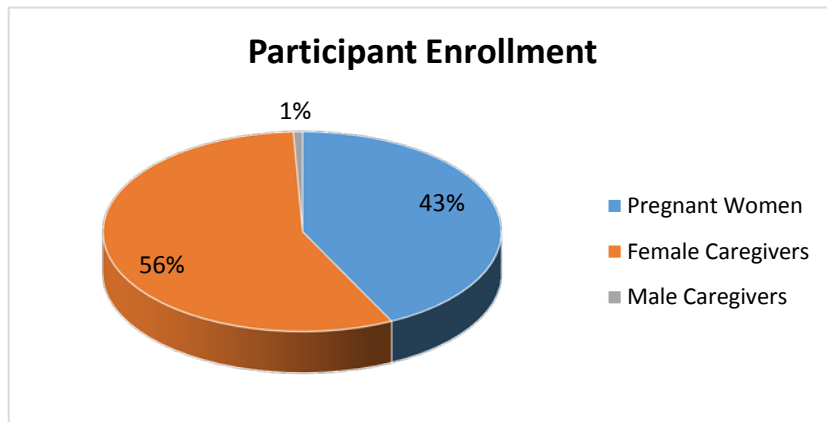

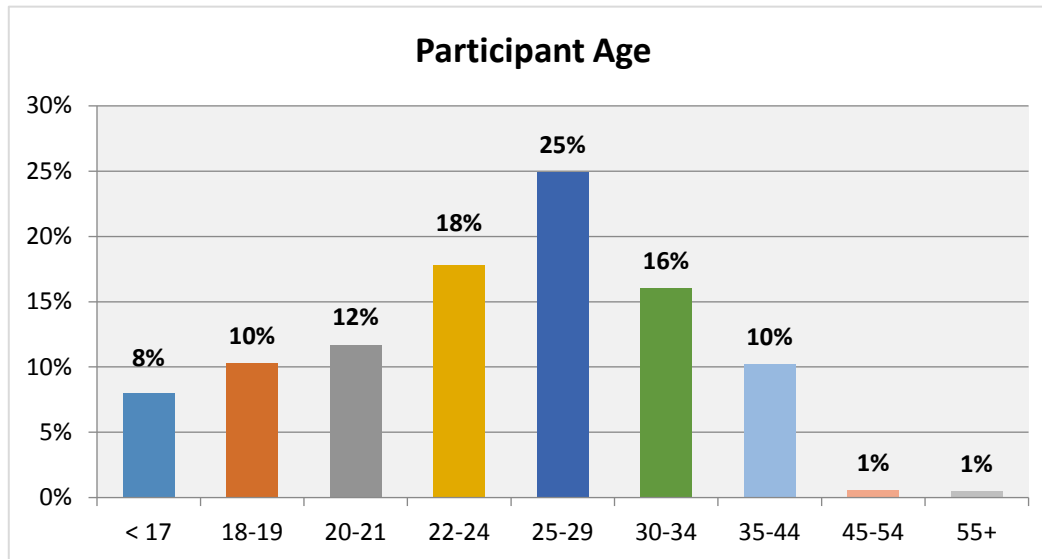

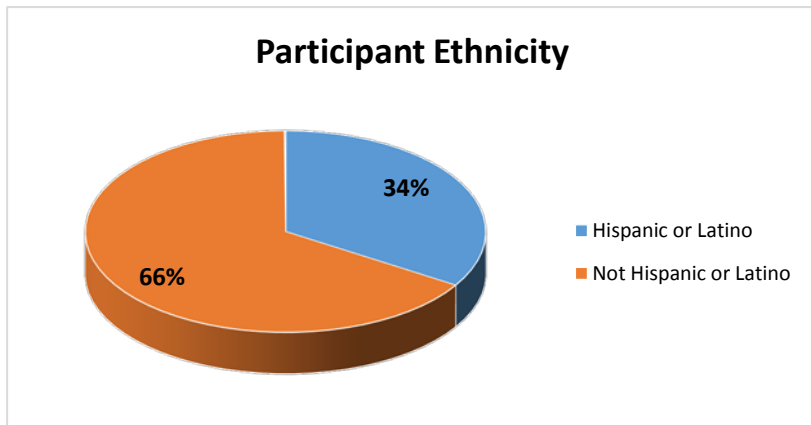

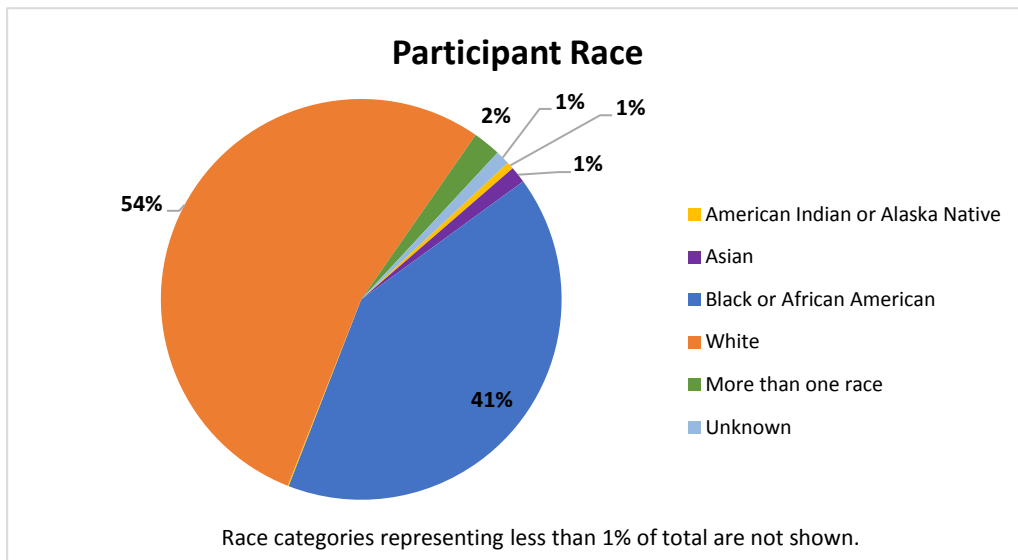

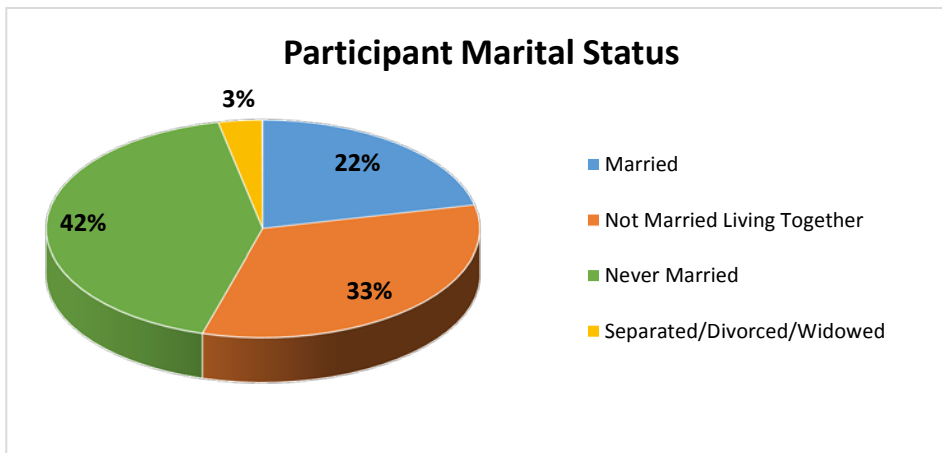

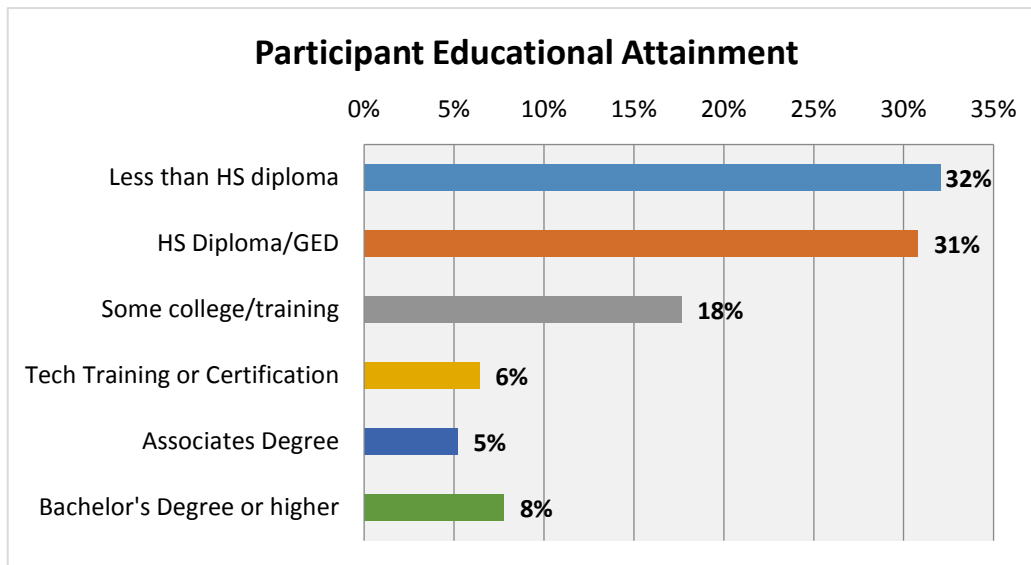

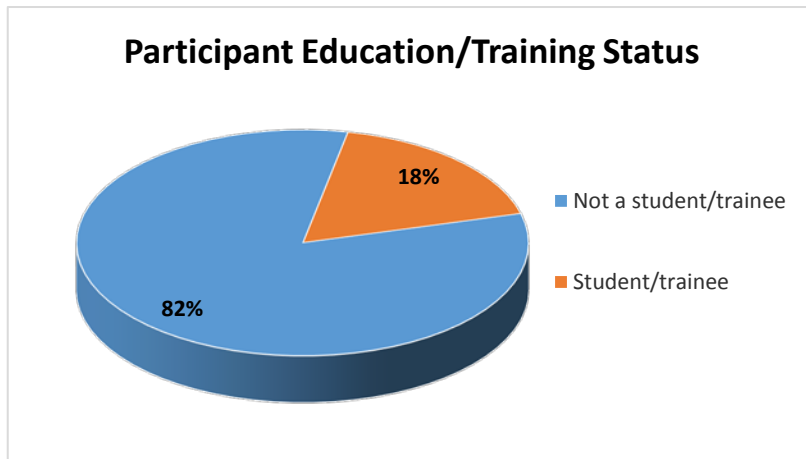

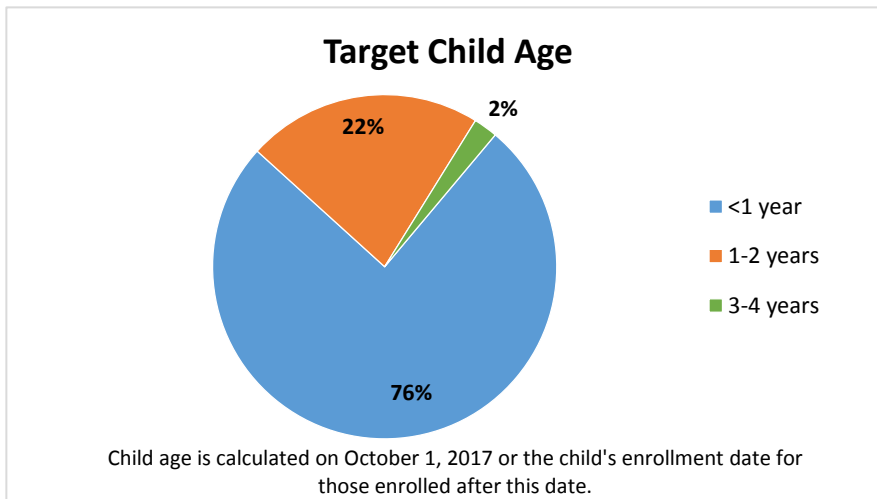

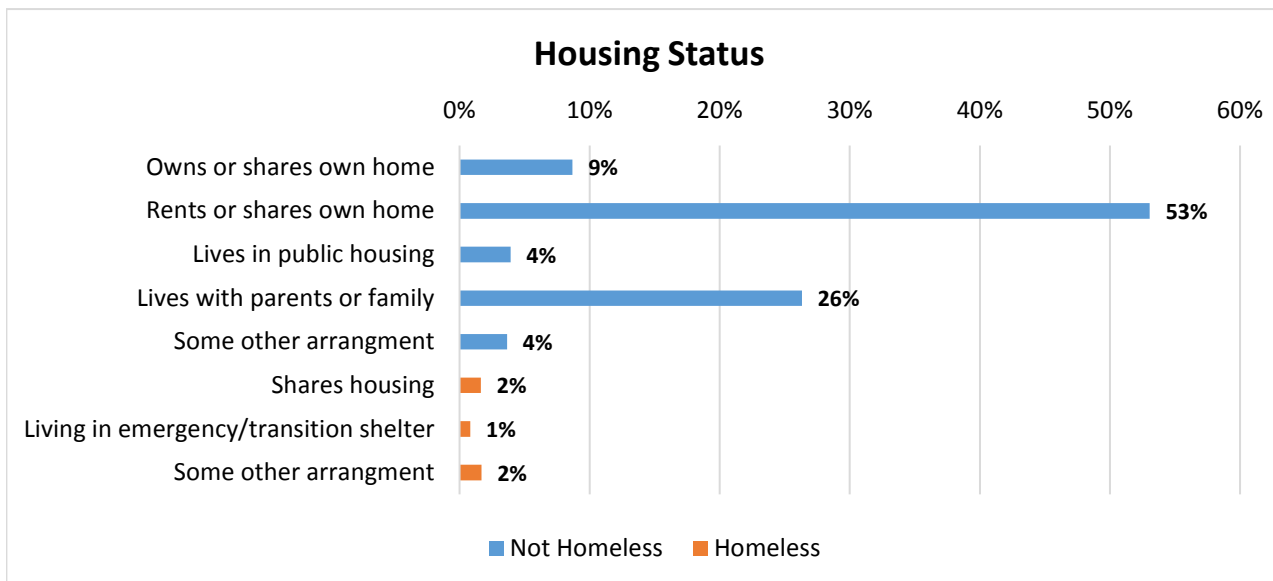

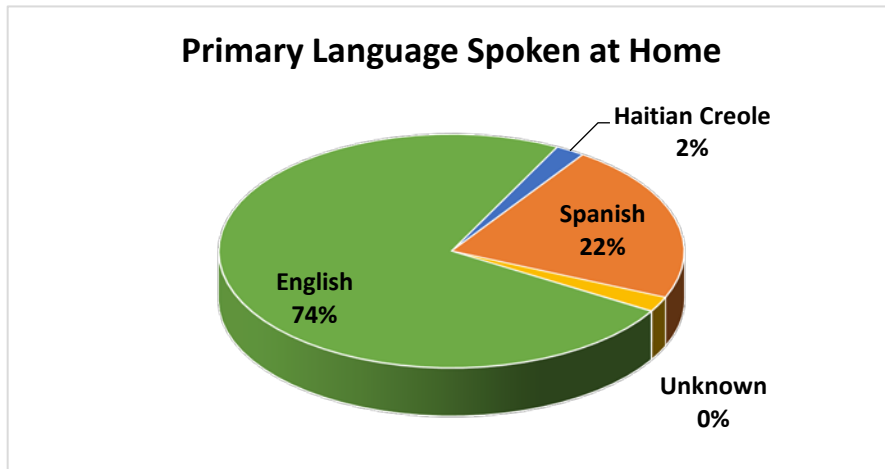

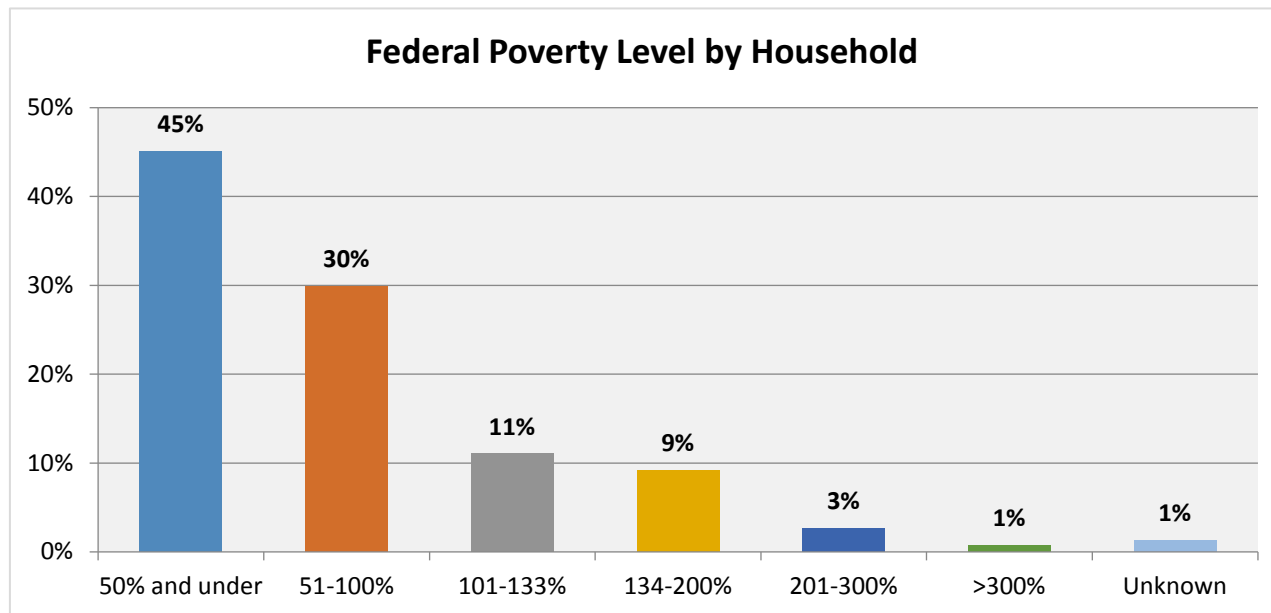

Enrollment by Model

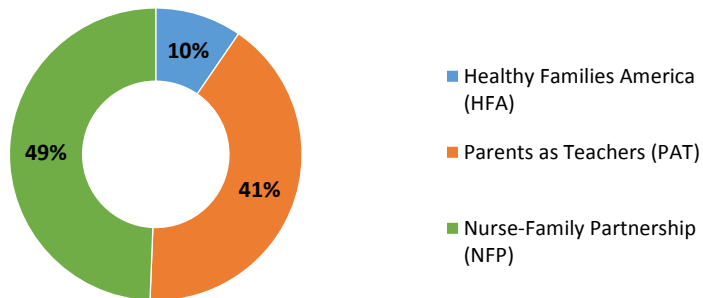

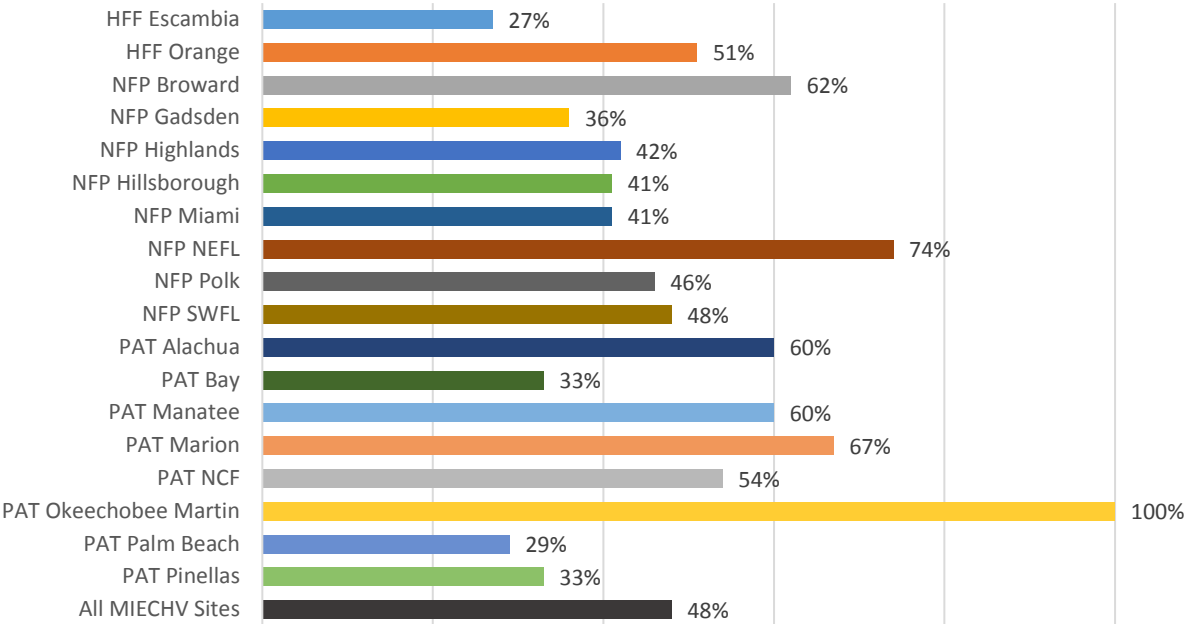
Retention Rates at 3 Months

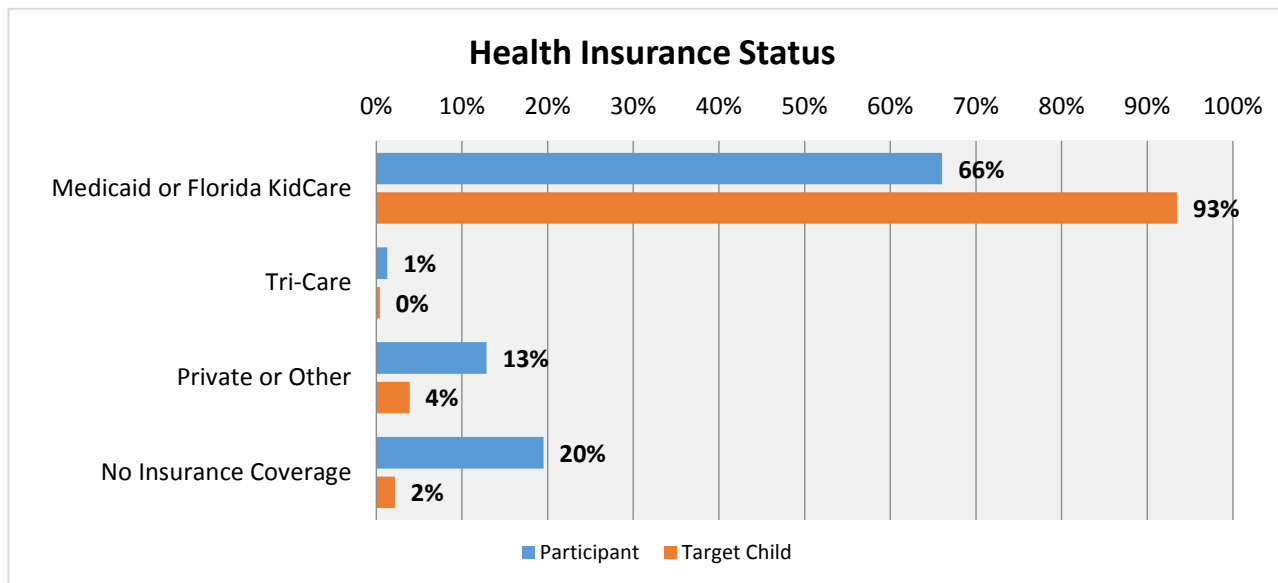

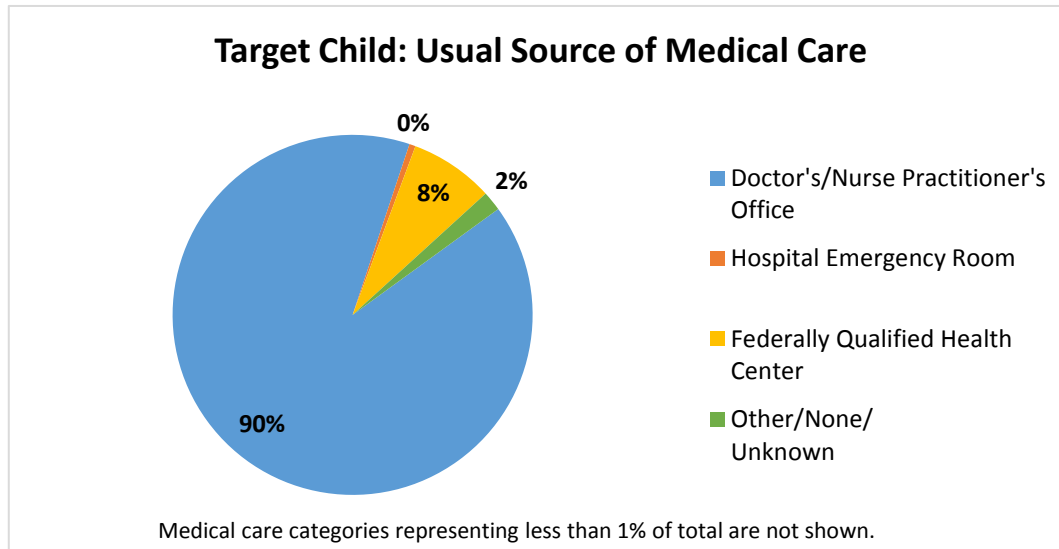
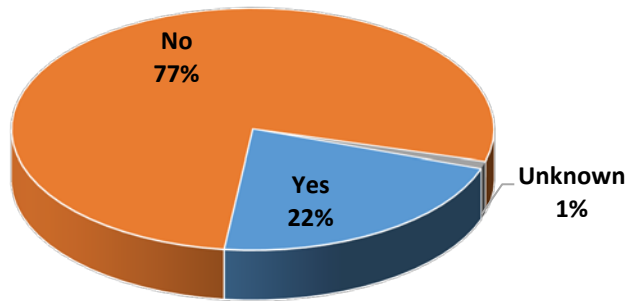
