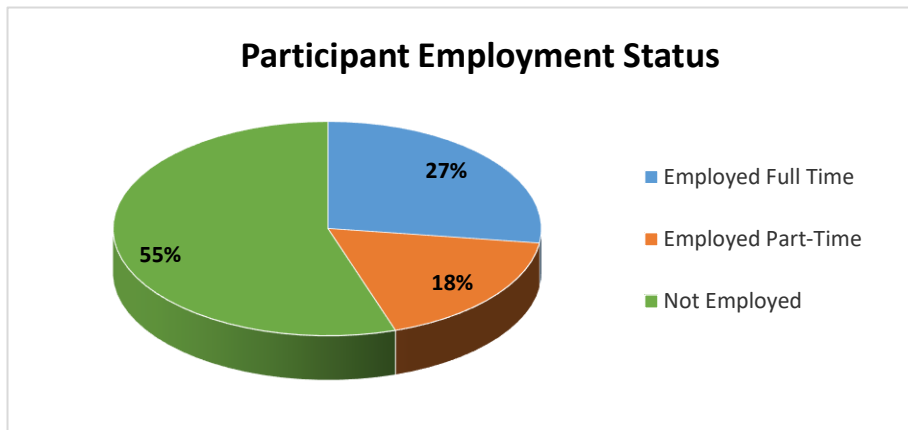

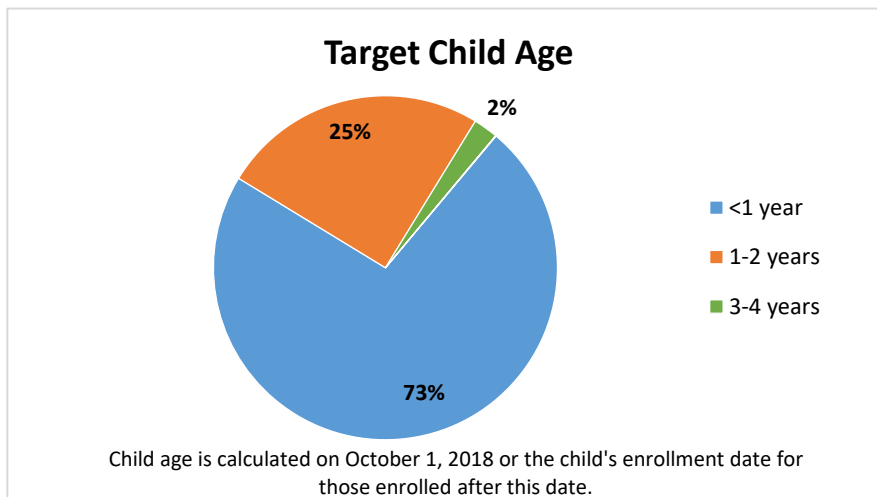

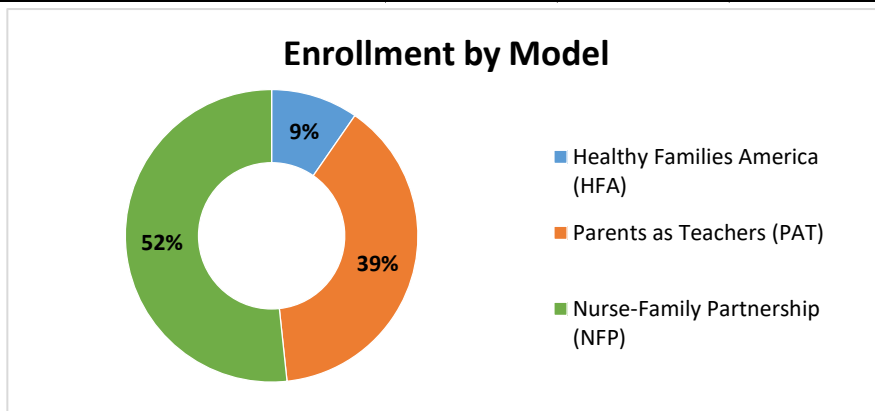

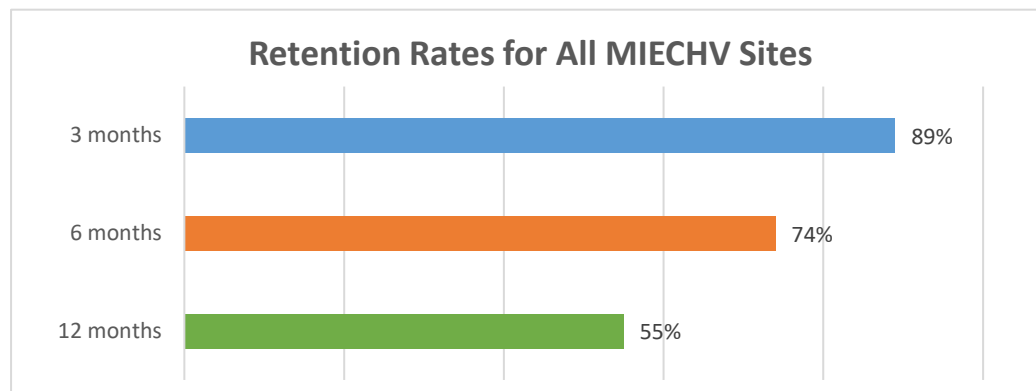

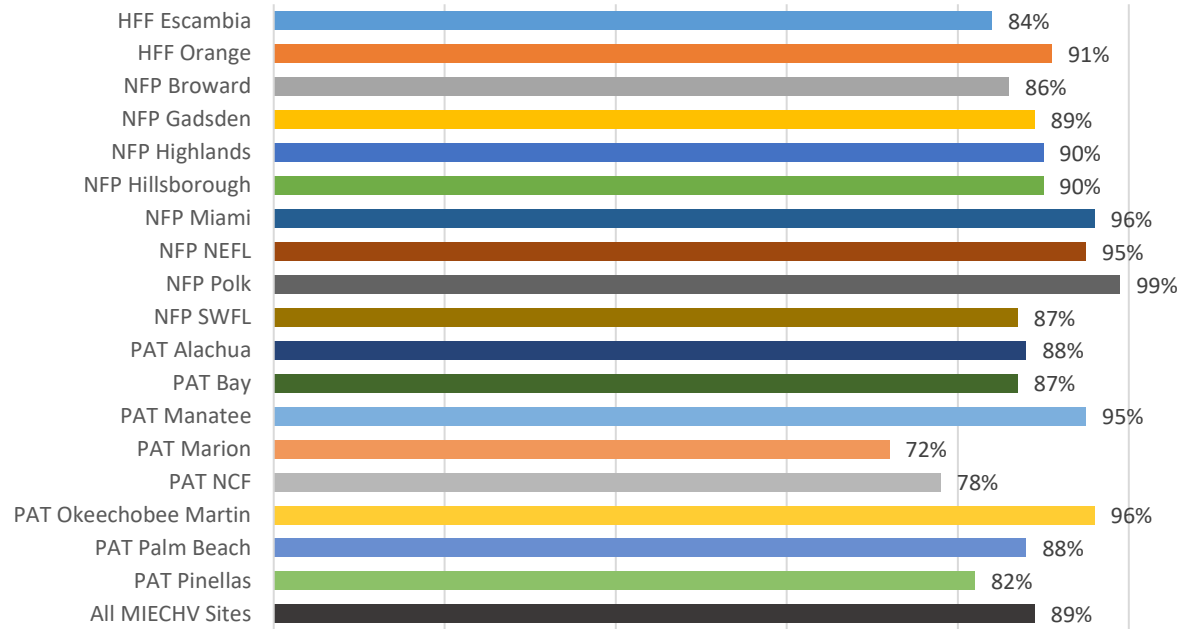

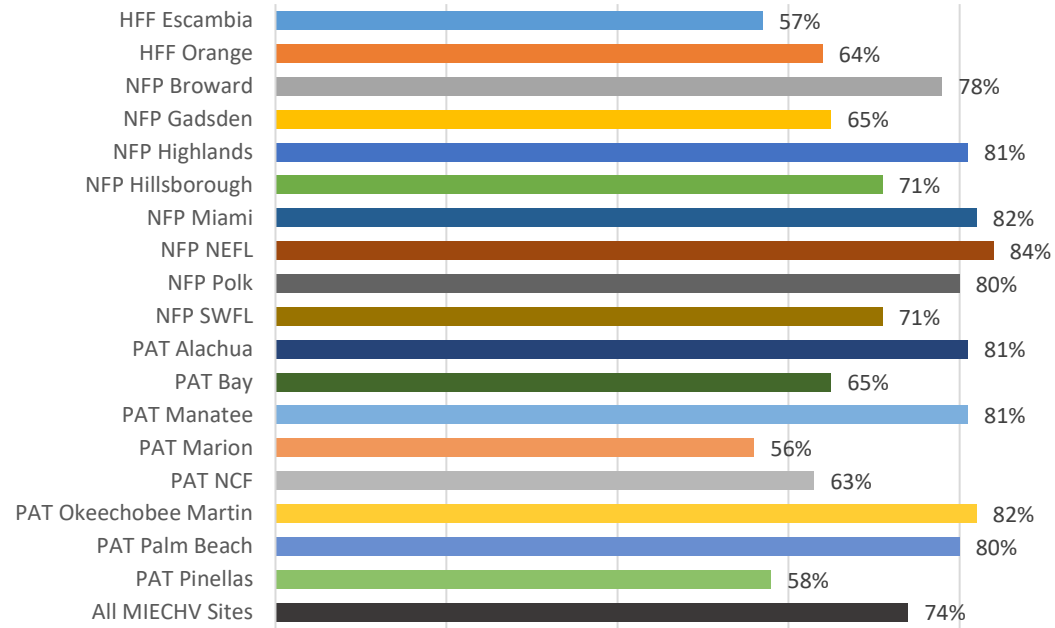

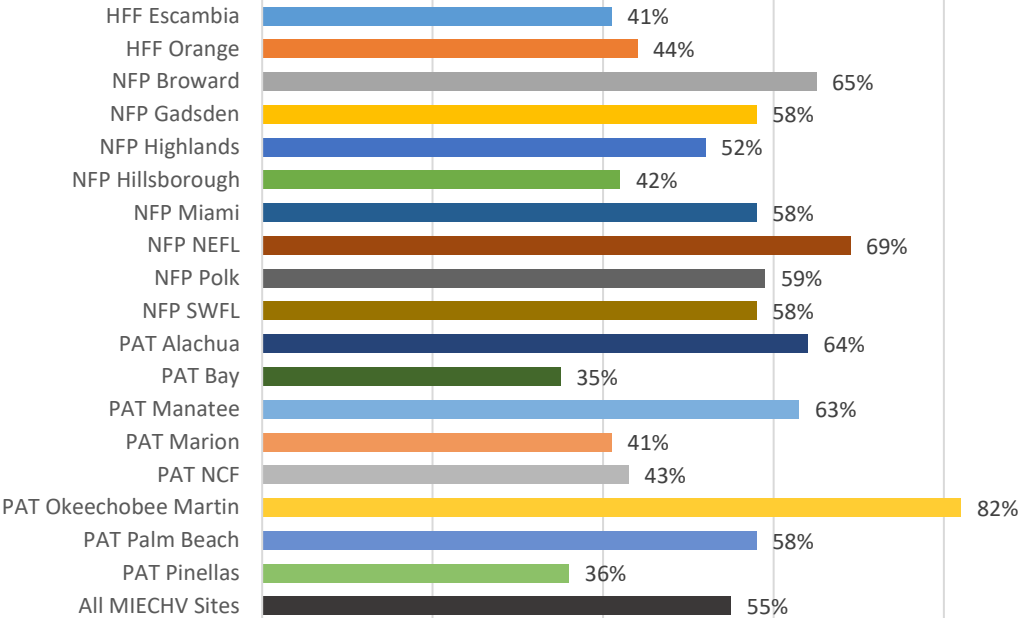
### Retention Rates at 3 Months

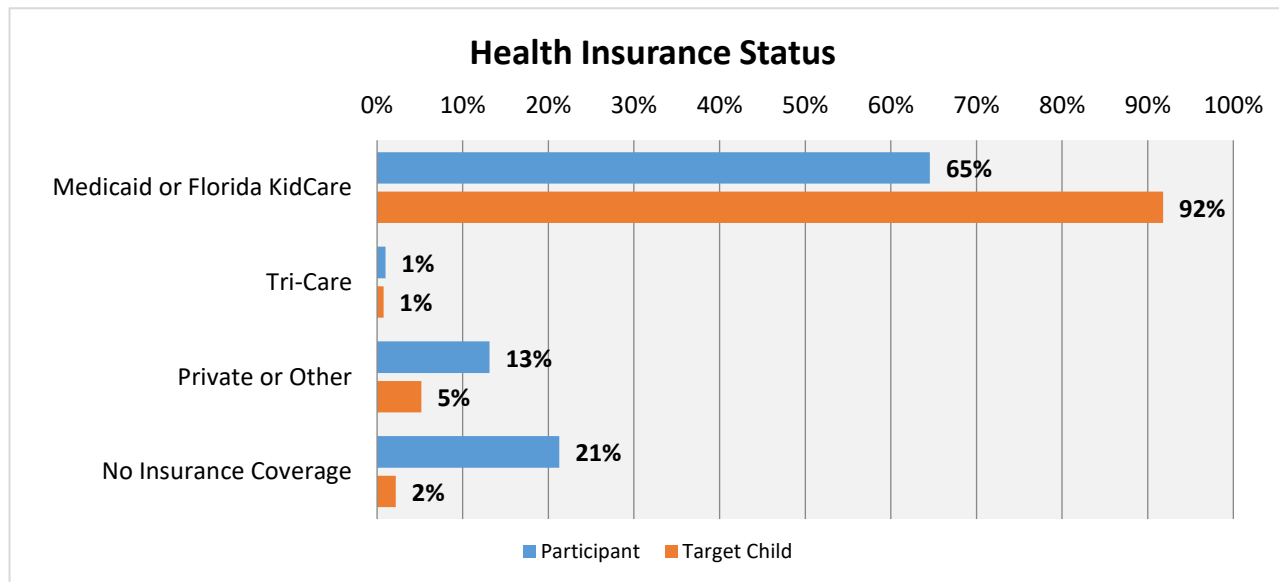

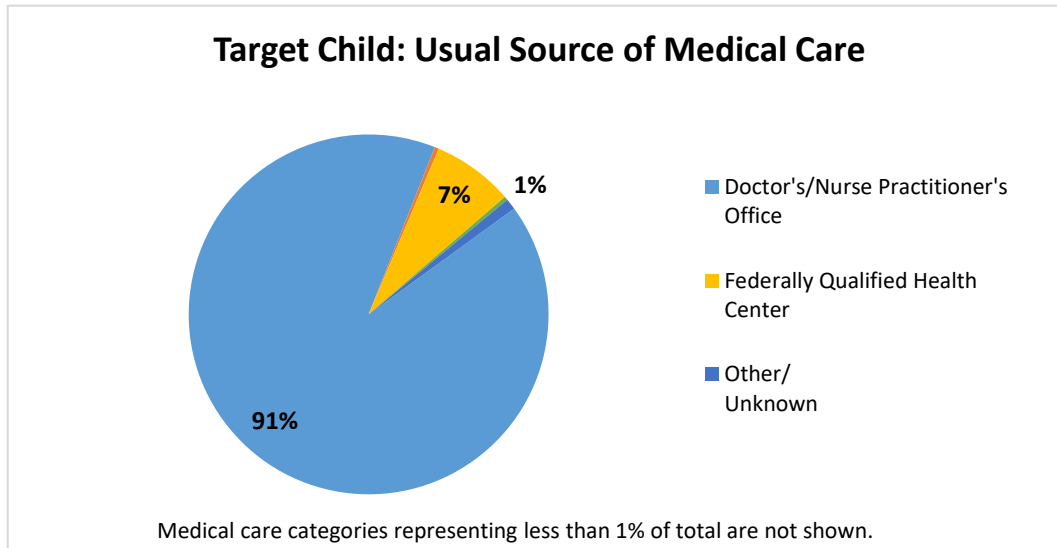
