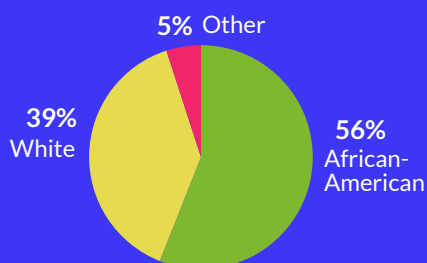

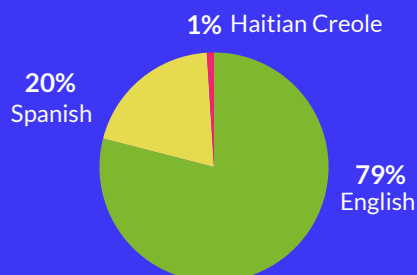
MIECHV Serves High-Need Families

- 7% Experiencing Homelessness

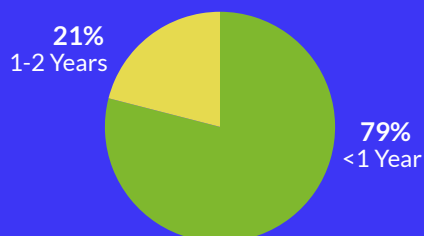
