2015-16 HIGHLIGHTS



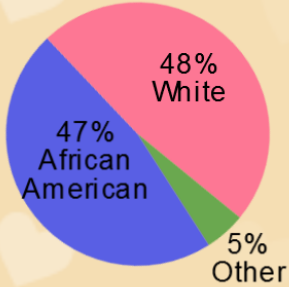
1,799 Families Served

- 1,460 Children

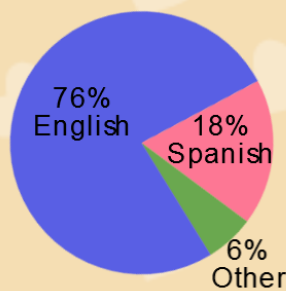
Among the 819 Families Newly Enrolled this Year:

- 19% pregnant women under age 21
- 24% with history of child abuse or neglect
- 19% have a child with developmental delays or disabilities
- 20% with history of substance abuse

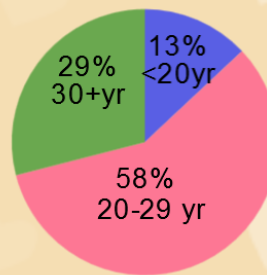
