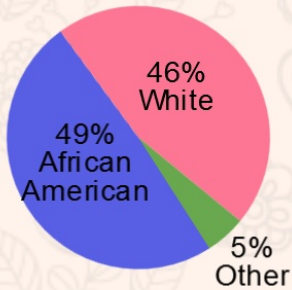
Year 2 Highlights



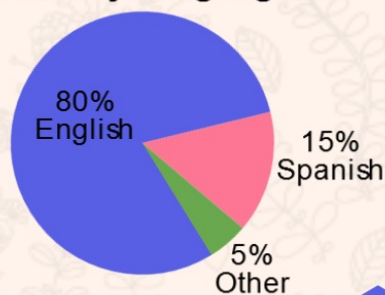
1,518 Families Served

- 1,224 Children

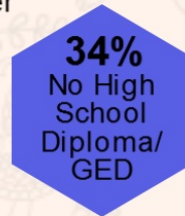
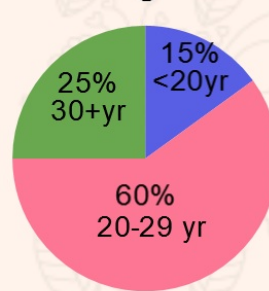

Among the 851 Families Newly Enrolled this Year:

- 19% pregnant women under age 21
- 23% with history of child abuse or neglect
- 19% have a child with developmental delays or disabilities
- 19% with history of substance abuse
