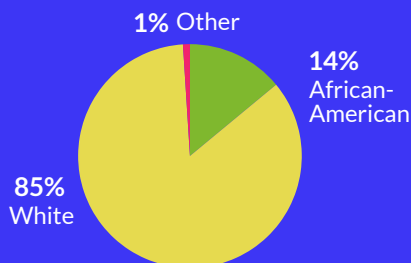

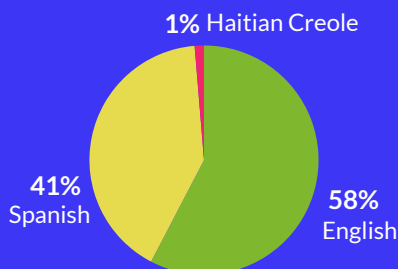
MIECHV Serves High-Need Families

- 19% Children with Developmental Delay or Disability

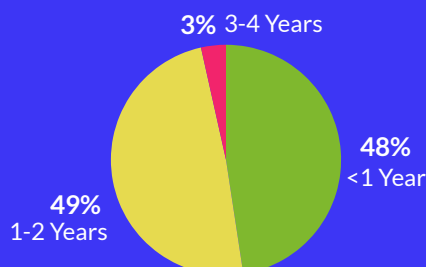
Participant Race

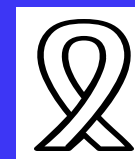
