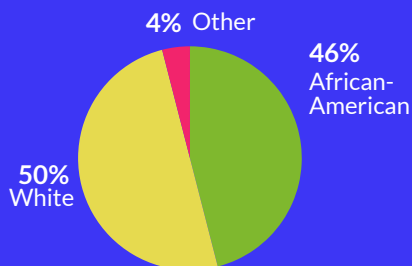

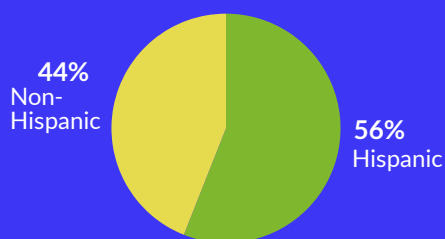
MIECHV Serves High-Need Families

- 31% No High School Diploma

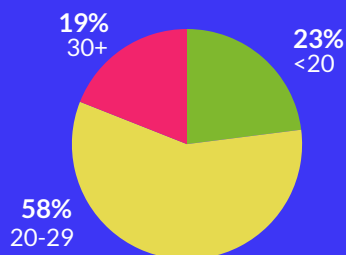
Participant Race
